### **Guest Curator – Cromarty Cinema**

**Are you passionate about film and interested in gaining hands-on experience in film exhibition?** Cromarty Cinema is offering a unique opportunity for a Guest Curator to spend time getting to know our rural community and develop a curated film event for local audiences.

Between October 2026 and January 2027, the Guest Curator will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the Cromarty community, explore what matters to local audiences and use this experience to shape and deliver specially curated screening(s) or film event(s) at Cromarty Cinema.

The role will provide a chance to learn more about film curation, audience engagement, programming and delivering events in a rural cinema setting, with support from the Cromarty Cinema team throughout.

The Guest Curator will be contracted by Cromarty Cinema in accordance with the fee noted above and the Cinema will cover associated travel and subsistence costs for time in Cromarty and at training days.

**No previous experience in film curation is required. This is an opportunity for someone with a passion for film who is interested in developing their skills and gaining hands-on experience in film curation and exhibition. Applicants from the Highlands and Islands are particularly encouraged.** Participants must have:

- the right to work in the UK, and
- be registered for tax purposes in the UK

Please submit a **cover letter of no more than one page**, or a **video/audio application of no more than 3 minutes**, telling us a little about yourself, your interest in film and why you'd like to take part in the Guest Curator opportunity at Cromarty Cinema.



Please consider the following questions in your application:

- **Tell us a little about yourself and your interest in film or cinema.** What appeals to you about this opportunity?
- **What would you be interested in exploring or bringing to audiences at Cromarty Cinema?** Is there a particular theme, idea, type of film or community connection you'd like to explore?
- **What would you like to learn or gain from the experience?** This could be related to film curation, programming, working with volunteer teams, audience engagement, events or working in a rural cinema.
- **Tell us about any experience or skills you could bring to the role.** This could be from work, study, volunteering, creative projects or simply things you enjoy doing. No previous film curation experience is required.
